#### **Selection & Eligibility Criteria**

- Graduating from a Halifax Regional Municipality high school this year
- Continuing their studies in post-secondary education in September at a post-secondary institution in Nova Scotia
- Demonstrated community service
- Demonstrated financial need

- All sections of the application MUST be completed and submit by the deadline of: May 21st, 2024
- Only the successful candidate will be notified

- Include your letter of acceptance from your post-secondary institution
- Include **one** letter of reference indicating how they know you, knowledge of your personal accomplishments and any additional information they feel the selection committee should know

  - One from your community involvement
